Receipt of an invitation, submission of an application, or payment of fees does not guarantee a spot in the conference. Conference spaces are filled on a first come, first-served basis. Applications will be accepted until the conference or tent city housing is full. Additional applicants will be placed on a waiting list. ***You are officially registered when you receive your confirmation packet.***

The Philmont Training Center and the National Council Division or Committee responsible for the conference reserve the right to reject any applicant. The Philmont Training Center cannot take phone or fax reservations; all reservations must be accompanied by a payment.

If your application has a pre-printed ID Number in the Council Approval section, your invitation to attend a conference has been approved by your council and you can send your registration directly to Philmont. If not, please contact your local council for approval to attend a conference. If your spouse plans to attend a conference, he or she must also be approved by your council. Please inform your council of any changes. Scouters invited by the National Council are limited to attendance in the conference to which they are invited.



Please be aware that the altitude at the Training Center is 6,621'. It is not advisable for you to attend if you are in poor health as walking at this altitude can cause severe physical strain.

Only members of your **immediate** family (spouses, sons, and daughters may attend with you). One additional non-family Mountain Trek participant may attend with each family Mountain Trek participant. Mountain Trek Participants must be 14 years of age by January 1, 2008, or have the completed the 8th grade and be at least 13, but not yet 21. *There can be no exceptions to these policies.* **Mountain Treks are not available during Week 1 or the Fall Conference week. Groups of smaller than 11 will be put into co-ed Venturing Crews.**

A complete information packet will be mailed to you upon *confirmation of your registration*. Please allow a 30-day turnaround for confirmation. Do not make travel arrangements until you receive a confirmation. Sorry, we cannot give telephone confirmations.
