A **16 Hour** Course which builds on the First Aid and CPR classes. This course is designed to train you in rural and outdoor settings in how to respond to emergencies; using what you have. It will teach the principles of “When Help is Delayed” and “Mountaineering Skills”. This course is available to all registered Boy Scouts, Ventures, and all Leaders if prerequisites are met. Participant must attend both days for certification. (This course is no longer recommended to have, it is now a BSA Policy Requirement. As of 2008, the requirement is for at least one leader in each group, not just unit, must have this certification for high adventure camps. So, if your unit has a trek that will be broken into multiple groups you will need one leader per group.)

***Wilderness First Aid Certification expires every 3 years.***
