

Unit Registration Check List

Resident Camp

- Adult in Camp Compliance form, one for every adult; submitted to Bay Area Council by July 2nd
- Camper Release form, one for every Scout who does not have a parent onsite; kept by Unit Leader
- First Aid Kit (small kit for campsite)
- Hazardous Weather* Training certificate, one adult per registered group
- Leader's Guide
- Medical form (Parts A & B), one for every participant; two copies alphabetized in a notebook or envelope (copy for campsite and Health Lodge)
- Roster, one per registered group, two copies (copy submitted at check-in and check-out)
- Sexual Offender database check, one for every adult
- Youth Protection Guidelines for Adults, Leaders, and Parent* Training certificate (classroom based YPT), one for every adult; training will be available at Camp Karankawa the first day
- Unit Membership Roster with participants highlighted
